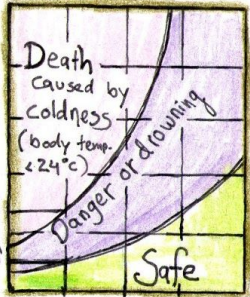
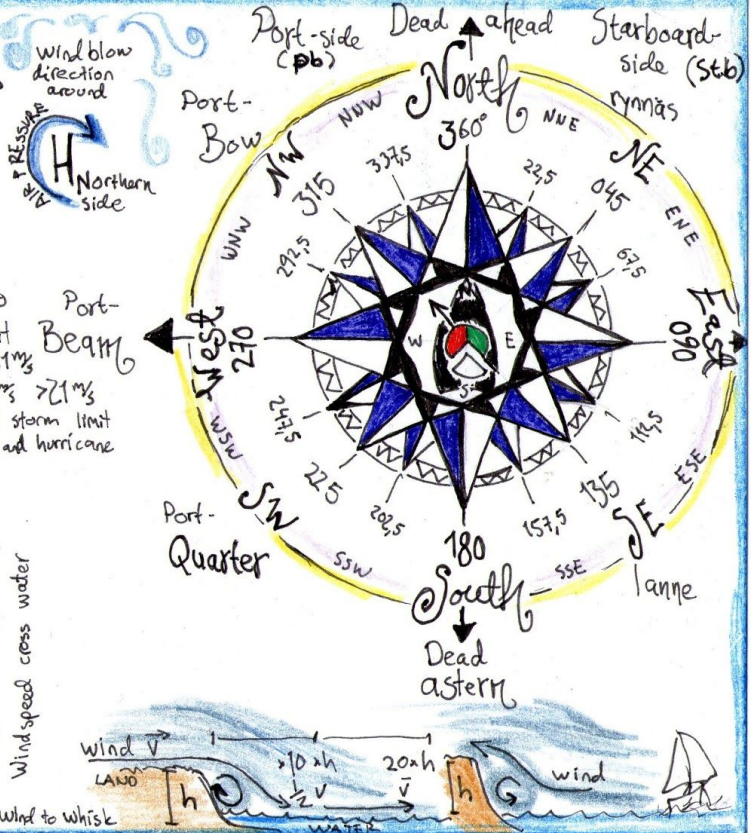
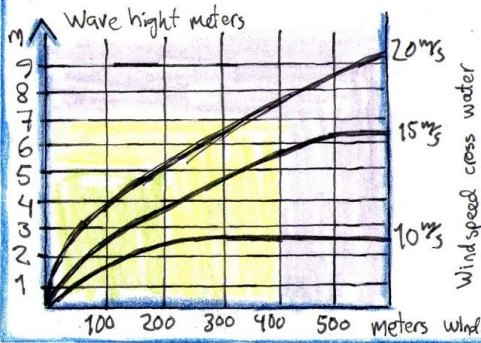

Sailboats' give-away rules:  
 • If the wind from different sides: the one who has the wind from port-side (left), gives away  
 • If wind same side: the one who's on the wind's side, goes away (wind's side = where wind's blowing) (from/other side than mainsail is held)

SOUNDS  
 ↑ --- go a.o.k!  
 △ --- I go pass left.  
 .... Your means unclear  
 △ --- I go pass right.  
 • I go right.  
 • I go left.
